Risk Assessment- Policy Statement

The Little Pips Pre-School believes that the health and safety of the children, staff and visitor is a priority.

Aims

We aim our setting a safe and healthy place to be at all times. Risks and hazards are identified, assessed and therefore minimised. Children can thrive in a healthy and safe environment.

Responsibility

Is the responsibility of the Management Committee to manage the risk assessment process.

Hazard identification is the responsibility of all staff members.

The process is shared in summary with key stakeholders including staff, volunteers, parents, work experience students and share appropriate children.

Risk Assessments Procedures

Little Pips Pre-School uses the following five steps to assess risks as follows:

- Identify the hazards indoors and outside
- Decide who might be harmed
- Evaluate the Risks-High, Medium or Low level

- Put in control s to reduce or eliminate risk
- Monitor and Review the assessment and control measures on a regular basis

Al findings are recorded in writing.

Checks

Daily, weekly, monthly, termly and annual checks are made as appropriate.

Examples are attached to this policy.

Check for hazards can be assessed at any time and in particular if something is new to the setting or changes have been made for the indoor or outdoor environment.
